

thence continuing West along the said South Line a distance of 354.0 feet; thence North 2°05' East a distance of 465.6 feet; thence North 62°39' East a distance of 244.0 feet; thence South 87°40' East a distance of 112.0 feet; thence South 2°00' West a distance of 286.6 feet; thence East a distance of 29.0 feet; thence South 2°05' West a distance of 287.0 feet to the place of beginning and containing 4.22 acres of land more or less but subject to easement for legal highways. In the bearings used it is assumed that the South Line of the N.E. 1/4 runs East and West.
